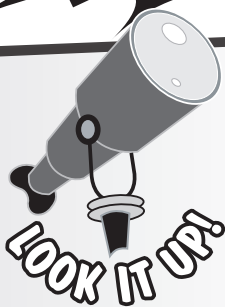

LEARN IT!

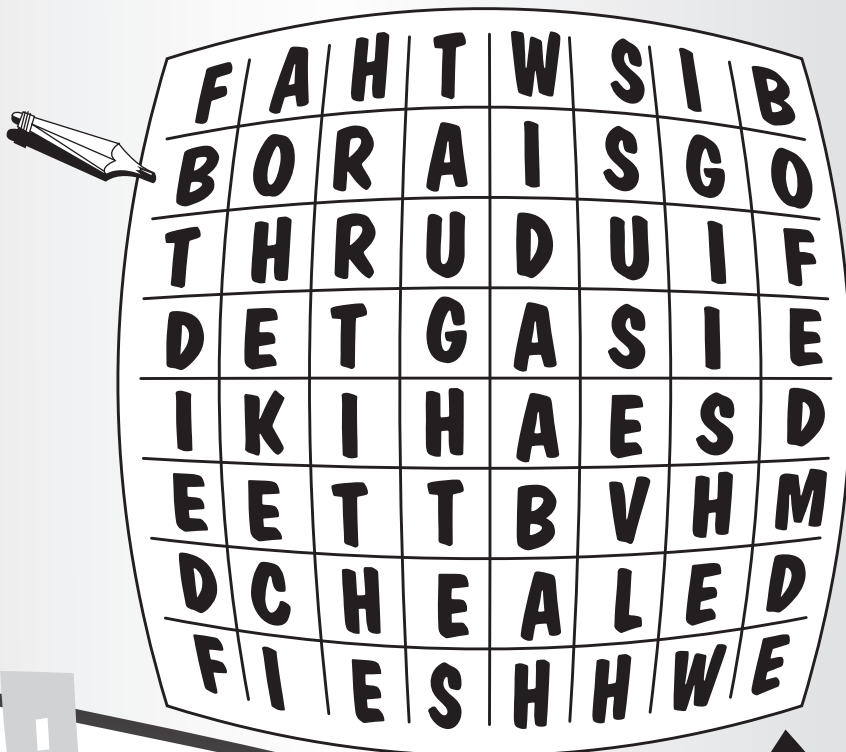
What makes us super is God's power in us. Jesus served others in a super spectacular way.
