# FACING YOUR FEARS

Joshua 1:1-9, 5:13-15 / John 14:23, 15:1-17 / 2 Timothy 1:7

Strength and courage come from the <u>choices</u> we make, more than the <u>feelings</u> we have.

"Do not be afraid" 120 times and "Do not fear" 131 times!

Obedience will always precede God's blessing.

God's blessings are his presence and his provision.

### Facing the fear of <u>failure</u>.

Luke 10:38-42

Q: Am I working against God, apart from God, or with God?

A: Truths to anchor your life in: Psalm 139 / Ephesians 2:10 / 1 John 4:7-21 / Jeremiah 1:4-5 / Ephesians 3:16-19

- God is everywhere.
- God can't leave me alone.
- God is still there when life is unfair.
- Our value is not found in who we are, but WHOSE we are.

Facing the fear of <u>money</u>.

Philippians 4:11,12 / Hebrews 13:5,6 / 1 Timothy 6:6 / Proverbs 23:4,5 / Ecclesiastes 5:10,11

A life free from excessive worry about money.

A life free from the endless pursuit of money.

Facing fear of <u>death</u> John 14:1-6 / 1 John 5:12 / Romans 10:9-13

Two questions we all have to ask:

- Can I trust God with my life?
- What step of faith do I bet my eternity on?

## THE BOTTOM LINE

Romans 8:12-17 & 8:28

Our confidence is not in Christ, but where we are in Christ.

Check out the following passages and jot down some blessings that God wants to give us and the part we play in receiving them.
