- 2. The Fool. (Proverbs 10:21; 12:15; 14:1,7-9; 17:21; 26:12; etc...)
- **3.** The Arrogant Mocker. (Proverbs 3:33,34; 9:7-12; 13:1; 14:6; 15:12; 21:24; 26:12; 29:8; etc...)
- 4. The Wise.
  - (Proverbs 8:33; 9:9; 10:8; 10:19; 12:15; 13:20; 14:16; 15:24; 29:11; etc...)

Someone who is wise can connect the dots between your <u>Present Actions</u> and <u>Future Reactions</u>.

#### The most important thing: <u>Be</u> <u>Teachable!</u> (Proverbs 1:7; 9:9; 15:5; 19:20,25)
