The Pharisees turned helpful spiritual *tools* into rigid religious *rules*.

Romans 14:1-7, Proverbs 30:5-6, Colossians 2:20-23, Mark 7:1-9, Micah 6:6-8

God doesn't want our <u>religion</u> - he wants a <u>relationship</u>. Isaiah 1:11-20, John 1:11-13, Romans 8:14-16, John 14:15

Neglect, replace the Word	Exalts the Word of God

# Digging Deeper Mark 7

The Pharisees often placed their cultural teachings and manmade rules on equal footing with the teachings of the Bible. Jesus responded to this practice in Mark 7:1-13. Read it and then answer the questions below.

What does He say are some of the results of elevating tradition and man-made rules to the level of the Bible?

As you look at your own life, are there any areas where you've allowed some tradition or man-made rule to have as much authority as the Bible?

What specific complaints does Jesus raise against the Pharisees' approach to tradition? Mark 7:6-13

What sorts of traditions do we observe today that get in the way of really honoring God?

How does Jesus' view of becoming "unclean" differ from that of the Pharisees (vv. 14–23)? Mark 7:6-13

In what ways do we sometimes emphasize appearance over internal reality?

Why is the condition of our heart so important to our actions?

Read Psalm 51:10. How can you have a clean heart?
