How great will be my <u>request</u>? Joshua 10:7-14

How far will I go to get to him? Mark 5:25-34

What am I willing to <u>overcome</u>? Mark 9:14- 32

When I pray remember:

My God is for me. My God is with me. My God forgives me. My God can do anything. And even if he doesn't yet **I still believe**.

LIFE GROUP HOMEWORK

Take some time to focus on the questions below and be prepared to share your answers with the group. Have a great meeting as you come together to connect and encourage one another to grow and to see God work!

GETTING TO KNOW YOU

What's one of the most miraculous things you've ever seen or heard about?

DIGGING DEEPER

Read and discuss Joshua 10:7-14. In this passage God answers Joshua's impossible prayer of making the sun stand still so that his army could prevail over the Amorites.

What are some of the miraculous things you have seen God do in your life or in the lives of others?

In what ways have you seen the sun stand still at Real Life Church?

How different do you think your life would be if you stopped asking God for simple things and instead ask Him to do mighty things?

Read and discuss Acts 4:23-37. In this passage, Peter and John prayed bold prayers before God that led to bold results.

How would you describe the way you typically pray?

In what ways do your prayers reflect what you believe about God?

What stood out to you about bold prayers after reading Peter and John's prayers in Acts 4?

Why do you think prayers become bolder when they are prayed together in a group?

What impact do you think it would have on your church if everyone began praying bold prayers?

Read and discuss Mark 6:30-44. This passage tells of how Jesus fed 5,000 people with just five loaves and two fish.

Why do you think miracles seem to occur less often today than they did in the Bible?

How has the love and involvement of others helped bring about miracles in your life?

How do you think God might want to use you to bring about a miracle in someone else's life?

Read and discuss Jeremiah 32:17, 1 Samuel 17:45-48, and Daniel 3:16-18.

Do you fully believe that God can do anything? If so, why?

Some people believe God can, but don't necessarily believe He will. Have you ever felt that way? If so, why?

Faith isn't built on what God does, but who God is. Who is God to you?

Take it Home

Talk It Over with God:

- Thank God for the miraculous things He has done in your life and in the lives of those you love.
- Tell God the things that are keeping you from believing that He can do the impossible. Ask Him to help you remove these things from your life.
- Ask God to show you the impossible goal that He wants you to accomplish. Ask for His help.
- Ask God to continue making the sun stand still in your church. Thank Him for all He has already done.
- Tell God your impossible needs that you need Him to meet. Ask for His help and commit to believing that He will meet those needs.
