Hope Springs Eternal

8 Finally, all of you, be like-minded, be sympathetic, love one another, be compassionate and humble. 9 Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult. On the contrary, repay evil with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing. 10 For, "Whoever would love life and see good days must keep their tongue from evil and their lips from deceitful speech. 11 They must turn from evil and do good; they must seek peace and pursue it. 12 For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their prayer, but the face of the Lord is against those who do evil." 13 Who is going to harm you if you are eager to do good? 14 But even if you should suffer for what is right, you are blessed. How to stay in touch with our Facebook and blog (and possibly win a prize)!

- 1. For **Facebook**, on your phone or tablet, it's pretty easy: just go to our page, Real Life Church, then click the little button with the thumbs up that says "like."
- 2. You'd think that would be all it took, but Facebook likes to make things challenging, so there's one more step if you want to make sure you actually get all of our updates. - 3. Okay, final step. *To officially enter the drawing*, leave a comment on our page! Comment on a recent post, leave a review to tell everybody how awesome you think we are, share a favorite verse, or just say hi!
- 4. If you have kids in Kidz Life or youth group, you'll want to get set up on those Facebook pages as well. We announce upcoming events and news on both pages, and if your child's MAP Book page happens to get lost during the week, you can get a replacement from the Kidz Life Facebook page. - 1. First go to www.seekreallife.wordpress.com, or just go to our church home page, click Social Media, then click Blog.
- 2. Scroll down a little bit and look for the section on the right that says "Follow Us." Enter your email address, then tap or click the button that says Follow.
- 3. Look for an email confirming you're signed up, then click the link in the email to confirm. Without completing this step, you won't get blog posts sent to your email.
