**Read John 14:1-7.**

How does Jesus describe himself in this passage? What can make his statement about himself difficult to swallow?

What is the significance of Jesus saying I am...

... "**the** truth" as opposed to "**a** truth"?

... "**the** life" as opposed to "**a** life"?

What do you do when what Jesus reveals about himself in scripture conflicts with what you thought about him?

How can knowing Jesus as Eternal God change the way you view this passage?

Why were the disciple's hearts troubled? How does the previous chapter help us with this question? (specifically John 13:21-38)

Why would knowing Jesus as the way, the truth and the life give comfort to these troubled followers?

**Read John 14:5.**

What type of "knowing" was Thomas referring to? Intellectual or relational?

**Read John 14:4 & 14:6-7.**

What type of "knowing" was Jesus referring to? Intellectual or relational?

Do you ever seek knowing information, techniques or instructions about Jesus above knowing Him? If so, why?

Why do you think people pursue Jesus intellectually but not relationally? What would life look like if you did both?
