Read Acts 17:16-34.

What does Jesus being raised from the dead say about who He is?

Read 1 Corinthians 15:12-21.

What does Paul explain is the problem if we join those who say "there is no resurrection"?

Why is Jesus being raised from the dead important for our lives today?

(If you want to learn more about Jesus' resurrection, our resurrection, what we will be resurrected to, etc., then read 1 Corinthians 15 in its entirety.)

Read Romans 10:9-13.

Paul presents two essentials in this passage that result in our rescue:

- 1. Confession that Jesus is Lord. (Lord=The eternal God revealed in the scriptures)
- 2. Belief in your heart that God raised Him from the dead.

What can make it difficult for you to confess that Jesus is God? If you were to take that risk by faith, what may result?

What can make it hard to believe in the resurrection? What kind of difference can that hope make in the way you live?

"Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent."

- John 17:3 (NIV)
