	 Pray for my next step in reaching the one I am praying for.
Read 1 Thessalonians 1:4-7. Who empowers the story we share about Jesus and what is He doing as we are sharing this story?	 Pray for boldness to reach our community with the love of Jesus.

Often times we don't know in the moment the impact of our story. What role do you think perseverance and trust has played in sharing your story knowing you can't possibly see the entire picture? Why do you think it's easy to give up on people?	
According to Paul, the things that should make Christians stand out are faith, hope, love, joy despite suffering, and a refusal to worship idols. Even as brand-new believers, the Thessalonians were already becoming known for these qualities. What about you? What are you known for? How can you become known for faith, hope or love?
