Read Joshua 24:14-15.

Near the end of his life Joshua, the Israelite leader trained by Moses, makes a strong connection between our worship and serving. Have you ever thought of your service unto the Lord as worshiping Him?

What are ways you serve the Lord today? What are new ways you have felt Him prompting you to serve?

Read Hebrews 11:8-10.

When Abraham obeyed God's calling to go even though he didn't know where the Lord was leading. What did the writer of Hebrews call this? Have you ever stepped out in obedience to the Lord even when you didn't have all the pieces to the puzzle? What was that like?

Why do you think our relationship with God is so vital to our acting by faith on what He tells us to do? Has the relationship you've been building with the Lord also build your faith? If so, how? If not, why?

Read Joshua 24:14-15.

What benefit do you think there is from telling others of the great things the Lord has done for you?

Why do you think it's important for us to be a community that is quick to give thanks? What can this do for our attitudes and hearts?

What has God provided for you so far this year that you'd like to take some time to thank Him for?

What is one or two things you are thankful for as you think back on this Life Group session?
