Read Psalm 5:9-12.

What is this poem contrasting? What are the blessings of drawing near to God v. rebelling against Him?

In what way have you experienced God's protection, His shielding love?

Read Genesis 15:1-6.

What is the first thing the LORD says to Abram in the vision? Why does He begin with Abram's fear, need of protection, and God being his very great reward?

In what ways do you struggle believing what God says about your situation? How does the story of Abram help grow your belief in God's faithfulness to His promises?

Read 2 Corinthians 4:14-18.

What is the result of God's grace reaching more and more people? Does this energize and renew your Spirit?

How do we keep our eyes fixed on things unseen when what we see in front of us is difficult and hard? How do you discern what really matters?

How can seeing God as great and that He desires to give you a full life help you when life presses against you?
