#### Read Psalm 146.

What advice are you given in this Psalm? Why is God a better choice to put your confidence in?

Take a moment and list all that God does in this Psalm:

Look over your list. Is there anything surprising to you? How does God compare to human rulers and leaders?

Do you have difficulty placing your hope in the Lord? Why or why not?

#### Read Acts 9:1-19.

How did God surprise Saul and the church? Are we prepared to love those who have even been an enemy of God?

To get Saul's attention God had to physically blind him. Has God ever used physical means to get your attention? (i.e. sickness, pulling a muscle, breaking a bone, etc.)

When Saul could physically see he was spiritually blind. What does it take for God to bring sight to your spirit? What do you think you may still be blind to? Do you believe God can give you eyes to see?

# **Real Life Prayer for 2020**
